NEW BEHAVIORS FOR THE WEEK:

- 1. SOCIAL SKILLS
  - a. CRADLE AND MESSAGE
    - i. (FEET, TEETH, EARS, TAIL AND PRIVATES)
    - ii. MUST BE QUIET AND CALM NOT A REV UP GAME
  - b. FROM THIS POINT IF I AM TALKING... YOU MUST BE DOING CRADLE AND MESSAGE
  - c. BARKING...WHAT ARE YOU ALLOWING YOUR DOG TO PRACTICE?
    - i. IF YOUR DOG IF BARKING LEAVE THE ROOM!
    - ii. DO NOT MAKE EYE CONTACT
    - iii. UNTIL CALM YOU CANNOT MOVE TO THE NEXT LEVEL
    - iv. IF YOU CANNOT GET UNDER CONTROL YOU WILL HAVE TO SWITCH TO PRIVATE LESSONS... FULL CREDIT OF GROUP PRICE TO PRIVATE TRAINING...
  - d. HAND FEEDING!
    - i. EASY, GENTLE AND WAIT
  - e. 50 FIRST DATES!
- 2. BASIC COMMANDS
  - a. MARKS

- b. NO REWARD
- c. RELEASE (ALL DONE)
  - i. UNLESS YOU ARE HAND FEEDING YOU ARE NEVER ALLOWED TO HAND FOOD TO THE DOG... THEY COME TO YOU ON THE RELEASE!
- d. DON'T BOTHER WITH A NEG MARK
- 3. THE COMMANDS... STAY COMES LATER
  - a. WATCH ME
  - b. SIT
  - c. CHIN
  - d. DOWN
  - e. TOUCH/RELEASE (ALL DONE)/STAND
    - i. IT'S ALL PRETTY MUCH THE SAME
- 4. COME WHEN CALLED/ RECALL
  - a. PING PONG
- 5. LEASH SKILLS
  - a. DON'T TURN YOUR BACK ON ME
  - b. NO WORDS AND NO COMMANDS
  - c. AUTO SITS!!!!

## The Keep it Simple Stupid (KISS) Dog Training Pledge to Great Dog Ownership...

&

What is expected in the Dog Training Process?

- 1. Dog training is about consistency and frequency of practice... If you don't practice daily (short intervals 10–15 minutes a couple times a day) don't expect any results
- 2. Dog training is 70% management (paying attention to the dog and eliminating the opportunity to make mistakes) and 30% training....
- 3. Your Veterinarian should be part of the training process. Keep him or her in the loop with all aspects of your training...
- 4. Keep your dog up to date on vaccinations and do at least one well check visit each year!
- 5. If I send you books or articles they too are part of the training process and you need to read and review them to make sure you completely understand the process
- 6. Each person in the family must be on the same page and pulling the rope to successes rather than not helping and leading to failure...
- 7. Your dog's behavior and well-being is your responsibility and it is up to you to be an advocate for your dog. Never put them in a situation they cannot handle
- 8. Your dog is a lifetime commitment... Your job is to keep them happy, healthy and safe
- 9. Understanding that dogs have just as many personalities as people and that expecting your dog's personality to conform to yours is not always feasible...
- 10. Looking for or expecting a quick fix will only guarantee one thing, frustration and disappointment on your part....
- 11. Schedule changes or cancellations need to happen with at least 48 hours' notice... No threats or policies, just the right thing to do! :-)
